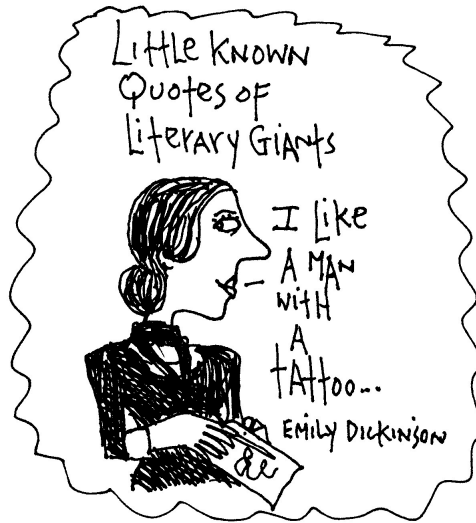


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Greetings, AmLit Scholars—

Homework:

1. On a separate sheet of lined paper, complete the “Strengthening Key Verbs” worksheet. Note: you will need to submit a **hand-written hard copy** of this assignment.

For each question:

- Completely revise each sample sentence to strengthen the verbs.
- List all of the strategies you used to make the verbs stronger.

2. Return to your Style Revision Draft and revise it to ensure that it meets expectations for verb strength in the first and last sentences of each paragraph. We will call this new draft the “Style Revision Draft 2.”

3. Upload your “Style Revision Draft 2” to Turnitin.com prior to the start of class.

4. Print two (2) hard copies of your “Style Revision Draft 2” (please print double-sided copies!) and bring them to class.
